**Public transport to Amersfoort train station:**

There are direct trains from 'Schiphol airport' (Amsterdam airport) to 'station Amersfoort' every day two times an hour (5 and 35 past the hour). The journey takes approximately 45 minutes. There are also a few indirect trains via Amsterdam Central Station.

You can buy your train tickets (single-use chipcard or OV-chipkaart) at the yellow ticket machines in the train station. The single-use chipcards are only available at the ticket machines with a blue overhead sign 'Train tickets'. The ones with a yellow overhead sign are only for use with the OV-chipkaart. Tickets are also available at the Ticket- and service desk. Please make sure you check-in and check-out (also with a single use ticket) before and after your journey at the yellow poles.

**By car:**

From Amsterdam:

- A1 in direction Amersfoort
- Exit 12 Amersfoort/Bunschoten-Spakenburg
- Turn left at the end of the exit
- Follow N199
- Turn left at the second traffic lights after the flyover
- Follow signs P-centrum: Parking garages Stadhuisplein, Sint-Jorisplein, Agis

**Walking from Amersfoort train station to the Cultural Heritage Agency (RCE):**

From Amersfoort central station it will take you approximately 10-15 minutes to reach the RCE by foot. When you exit the main entrance of the station, turn left and follow the signs Centrum. After the flyover (crossing a railway track), take the first road to the left. This is Wijersstraat. At the end you turn right to the street named Smallepad. This road runs parallel to the railway. After about 600 metres you will arrive at the RCE (left side of the road).

**Public transport from Amersfoort train station to RCE (Cultural Heritage Agency):**

You can travel by bus to the RCE. You can choose from the bus lines 1, 2, 3, 4, 74, 76, 103. Please get off the bus at the first stop, next to the city hall. From here you walk to the left, in the direction of the flyover. Enter the small park at the first path to your right. Cross the park diagonally and turn left at the end. You are now in front of the RCE.
